

liberty to attend to any further practices relevant to their society outside the precincts of the mosque .

Counsel for the Petitioners submits that persons returning and others belonging to the Society would be entitled to the facilities connected with marriages and burial in keeping with the applicable law without complying with any further requirements. Mr Kariappan agrees to this since they are matters of law. On the basis of the foregoing persons who were displaced would return within two weeks from today. Deputy Solicitor General who is present submits that he would inform the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Respondents to facilitate such return and to ensure that the fundamental rights of these persons are not infringed .

Mr Faiz Musthapha PC who appears for the 6th Respondent submits that the 6th Respondent is the all Island corporate body which is not directly involved in the matter but he submits that the President and the Secretary of the Kattankudy branch of the 6th Respondent are present in Court and have agreed to the arrangements that have been recorded.

The 6th Respondent is discharged from these proceedings.
